SPA TECHNICAL GUIDANCE DOCUMENT

PROFESSIONAL POST-WRAP TREATMENT GUIDE

A rich, water-activated body polish designed to soften and condition skin while rinsing to a moisturized, smooth after-feel without intentionally leaving a heavy or greasy oil layer.

FORMAT

Anhydrous body polish

RECOMMENDED USE

Approx. 2 oz / full body

Post-Wrap Treatment Protocol

Use this sequence after the spa wrap has been completed and removed. Maintain the spa's normal client-safety and wet-area procedures throughout the service.

1

Complete the wrap

Remove wrap materials according to the spa's normal protocol and keep the client safely positioned.

2

Dampen the skin

Introduce warm water before or as the polish is applied.

3

Apply sparingly

Use approximately **2 oz for a full-body treatment** as the starting amount. A little goes a long way.

4

Massage

Work gently in circular motions over the body, concentrating on dry or rough areas. **Do not apply to the soles or bottoms of the feet.**

5

Activate with warm water

Add warm water gradually while massaging. This helps the emulsifying system disperse the oil-rich polish and loosen surface soil.

6

Rinse thoroughly

Use plenty of warm water. Continue rinsing until the skin feels conditioned without an excessively oily residue.

7

Finish

Pat skin dry rather than rubbing. Assess the skin before adding another moisturizer; additional lotion or heavy body butter may not be necessary.

SLIP HAZARD

Surfaces may become slippery when wet. Never apply Body Polish to the soles/bottoms of the feet. In wet-treatment areas, use a secure shower chair where appropriate or perform the treatment with a trained professional in a suitable therapeutic room. Thoroughly rinse shower, chair and treatment surfaces after use.

How the Body Polish Works

WATER-ACTIVATED RINSE-OFF

The Body Polish is water-free as supplied. During use, warm water interacts with Polysorbate 20 and the formula's emulsifying components. This helps reduce the interfacial tension between the oil-rich polish and rinse water, allowing the product to disperse into smaller droplets so excess product and loosened surface soil rinse away more readily.

The emollient system supports softness and helps reduce moisture loss at the skin surface. The goal is a conditioned, moisturized after-feel without intentionally leaving a thick residual oil film.

KEY CONDITIONING INGREDIENTS

Ingredient	Why it is used
Paraffinum Liquidum	Primary occlusive emollient. Supports softness and helps reduce moisture loss.
Polysorbate 20	Helps the oil-rich system disperse when water is introduced, improving rinse-off and reducing a heavy residual feel.
Caprylic/Capric Triglyceride	Light-feel emollient that contributes slip, spreadability and softness.
Persea Gratissima (Avocado) Oil	Emollient oil that supports skin conditioning and softness.
Cetearyl Alcohol, Glyceryl Stearate & Stearic Acid	Provide structure and contribute to the creamy, conditioned character of the polish.

HYDRATION CLAIM GUIDANCE

This formula is designed to support long-lasting moisturization. A specific **24-hour hydration** claim should be used only when supported by suitable finished-product efficacy testing. Until substantiated, recommended wording is **long-lasting hydration** or **leaves skin feeling moisturized and conditioned without a heavy oily feel**.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

Product type	Anhydrous professional body polish
Recommended amount	Approximately 2 oz for a full-body treatment
pH	Not applicable as supplied. A conventional aqueous pH should not be assigned unless CLC establishes a defined dispersion/extraction test method.

INCI INGREDIENT DECLARATION

Paraffinum Liquidum, Cera Alba, Cetearyl Alcohol, Glyceryl Stearate, Stearic Acid, Polysorbate 20, Caprylic/Capric Triglyceride, Persea Gratissima (Avocado) Oil, Parfum.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Q: I still feel oil on my skin after the shower. What should I do?

Use plenty of warm water and continue rinsing while gently massaging the skin. The emulsifying system needs sufficient water to disperse the oil-rich product effectively. Also reduce the amount used. Approximately **2 oz is recommended for a full-body application**. Over-application or insufficient rinse water can create a heavier after-feel.

Q: I want a thicker foam and stronger cleansing action.

A future formula variant may be evaluated with SCI (Sodium Cocoyl Isethionate) or SLSa (Sodium Lauryl Sulfoacetate). These are formulation changes requiring manufacturing, stability and safety review and should **not** be added by the spa to finished product at point of use.

GENERAL CAUTIONS

For external use only. Avoid contact with eyes. Discontinue use if irritation occurs. Follow the spa's workplace safety, client-screening, sanitation and infection-control procedures.

Formula record note: The supplied non-fragrance percentages total 100% before Parfum. Parfum is shown at the end of this requested draft INCI, but the final ingredient declaration should be verified against the actual finished formula before regulatory filing or label use.
